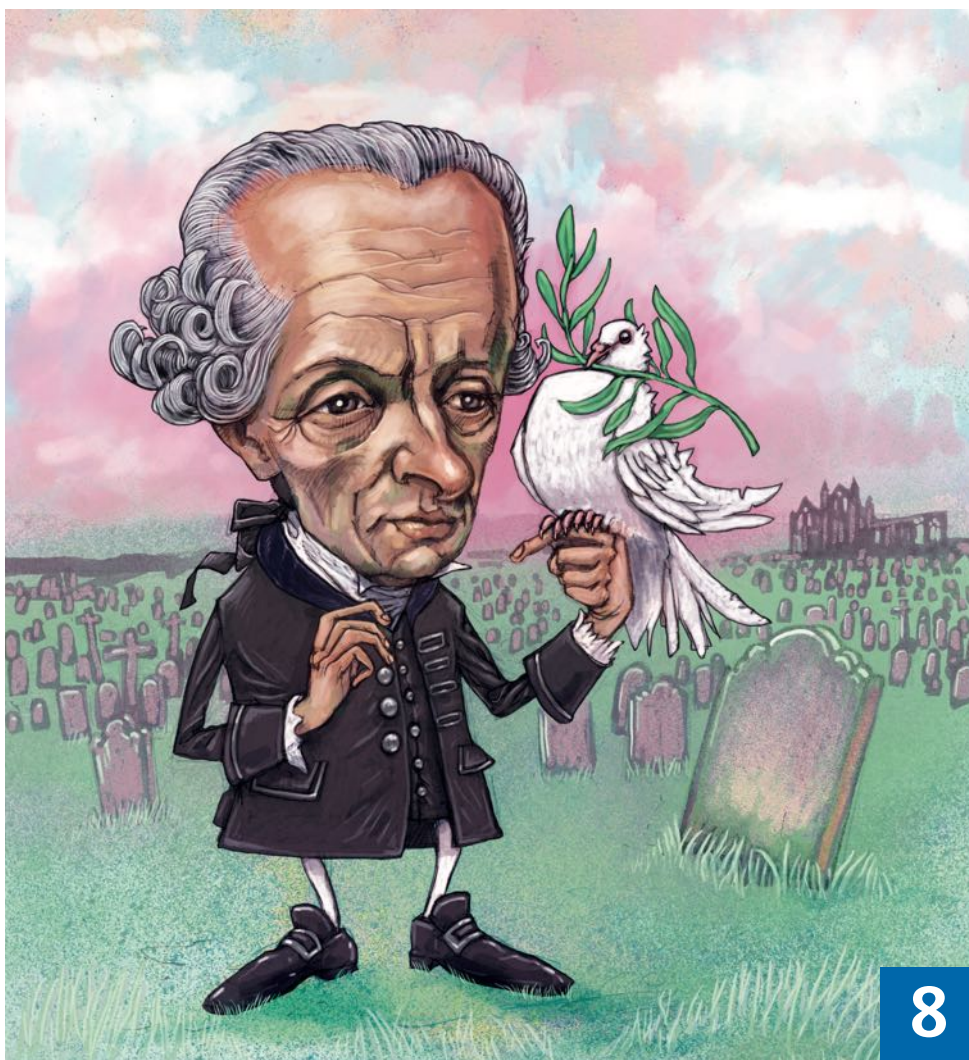

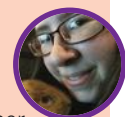

### Peter Stone

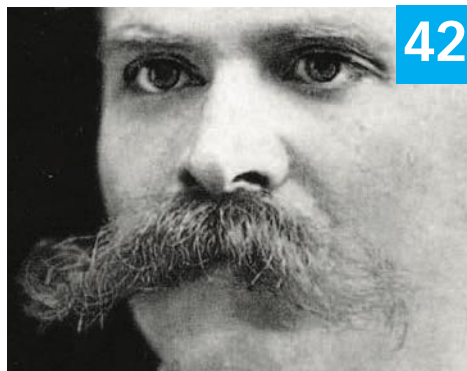
