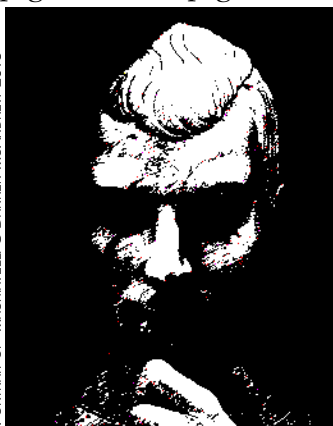

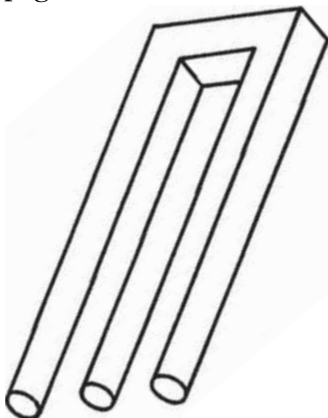


PORTRAIT OF MACHIAVELLI © DARREN MCANDREW 2013
