HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Lodging for conference participants has been arranged at the Orrington Hotel, 1710 Orrington Ave, Evanston, IL 60201. The conference rate (Thursday—Sunday) is \$149 plus taxes per night. All rooms are subject to state and local taxes (currently 13.5%). Reservations must be made by October 10th, 2014.

Please notify attendees to identify themselves as being with the **Hegel Society of America** to receive the group rate.
